She is able to see within 1.5 meters, and we were able to play a fun game of hide-and-go-seek with her!



Frankie is 8 years old and is quite a little comedian. He is diagnosed with a spinal nerve injury that affects the upper arm and mild curvature of the spine. He is a joy to be around and gets along well with others. He has an active mind in the class and is a quick learner. He is often praised by his teachers. He likes music and watching cartoons. He enjoys playing with other children, especially hide and seek. He is very much a "manager" and loves for things to be in order. He is very friendly and outgoing, and open to trying new things. He loves running and playing at recess. He is very excited to have a family of his own and would love to have lots of brothers and sisters.



Carissa is 13 years old and is post-operative for cleft lip and palate. She is a very loving, giving, caring young lady. She loves to help the nannies and learn to be independent.
